

Privacy Policy

Dana-Farber Cancer Institute Department of Data Sciences, Boston (USA) operates the CompositeRiskSTEPP website, which provides the SERVICE.

This Privacy Policy is used to inform website visitors regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of personal data if anyone visit the website and decided to use our Service, the CompositeRiskSTEPP website.

If you visit the website, then we process log data and cookies as personal data and as described below. The same applies if you choose to use our Service. Log Data

We want to inform you that whenever you visit our Service, we collect personal data that your browser sends to us that is called Log Data. This Log Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser version, pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, and other statistics. Log Data are stored for a maximum of one year.

Cookies

Rights

- lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
